



COVID-19 Sanitation Procedures

ALWAYS

- Hand washing for 20 seconds before and after physical contact with others
- Hand washing for 20 seconds before and after sessions and as necessary during sessions
- No touching of face - eyes, nose, and mouth
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or use the inside of your elbow when you cough or sneeze - immediately wash hands for 20 seconds

Hourly Sanitation

- Door handles
- Light switches
- Sinks & faucets
- Counter tops
- A/C unit keypads
- Waiting room table
- Coffee and water area

During Sessions

- Therapist initiates hand washing for self or child with any cough, sneeze, or runny nose
- Mouthed, coughed on, or sneezed on toys immediately put aside in a bin for sanitation
- No iLs units will be used at this time

After Sessions

- All large equipment used by child must be sanitized
- All toys used must be sanitized

Towels/Crash Pads/Couch Covers

- Washed at the end of each day
- If suspected respiratory droplets, it will be removed immediately
